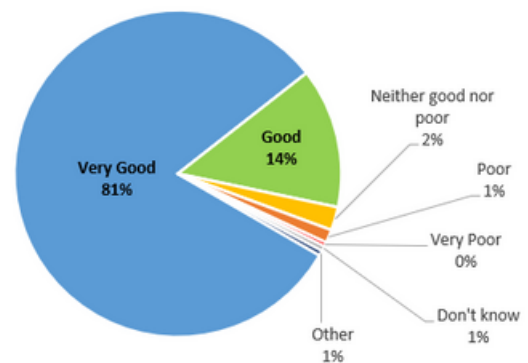
Eligible patients whose mobile details are up to date will be **invited to book an appointment via text message**; those without a mobile number will receive a telephone call instead.

Having your say

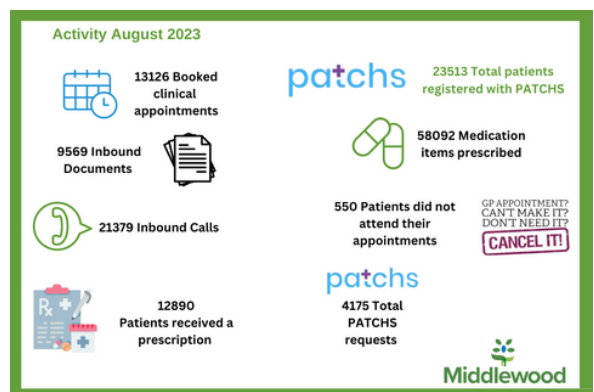
Middlewood deeply values the feedback of our patients, and so we have begun to send out a 'Friends and Family Test' survey patients via text message following each appointment with the practice.

Successfully establishing Continuity

In 2016, the Royal College of General Practitioners published a paper expanding on the benefits of patients routinely seeing their preferred or usual GP and establishing continuity of care.

Their paper stated that **“Patients who receive continuity of care in general practice have better health outcomes [and] higher satisfaction rates”**, and so in December 2022, Middlewood made the decision to move towards this continuity-based model of care.

What is continuity of care?

When we talk about “continuity of care”, we’re talking about our ability, as an organisation, to help build a lasting relationship between our patients and their GP.

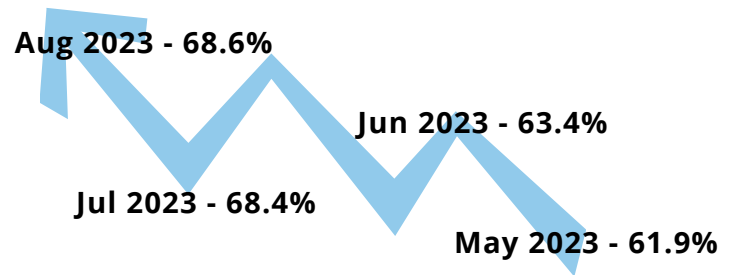
While we appreciate that one person can’t administer everything that a patient requires, their usual GP can act a “co-ordinator” for their care – helping successfully navigate a patient through various treatments by having a better understanding of their overall health and needs.



Routinely this means that our Patient Service Advisors will **primarily aim to book patients in with their usual GP** for any ongoing health concerns. This may mean that you have to wait a little longer for an appointment, though staff will also utilise appointments with other healthcare professionals for more specific or urgent needs.

As such, it is vitally important that our Patient Service Advisors understand the problem you’re currently experiencing; please understand that **this team are required to ask questions about your problem** so that they can find the most suitable appointment and help save you returning to the practice unnecessarily.

Since launching the continuity model in December 2022, Middlewood has only seen progressive improvements on the numbers of patients being seen by their usual GP, as shown by the statistics below.



Through our commitment to continuity of care, Middlewood is dedicated to delivering both compassionate and consistent care to you and your families.
